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


'A' Grade for the Third Consecutive Term







Bharat Abhiyan is inspired the Unnat by transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help building the architecture of an Inclusive India. V.O.Chidambaram College has initiated the campaign to survey the cluster of five villages as a participating institution in 'Unnat Bharat Abhiyan'. As a flagship programme of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) aims at enabling faculty and students of higher educational institutions to work with people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for accelerating growth of villages.




FLORET
